

## John 13: 1

Topic: a) Loved them till the end.

a) Marci and Leonna were friends. They loved being with each other. They promised that they would love each other as friends till the end. Then one day Marci bought a new pair of sneakers. ■ Did they love each other till the end?

## John 13: 3-16

Topic: a) Why did they wash feet?

a) It was very hot in Israel where Jesus lived (Still is). When someone had a special guest over to their house they would want to show how much they cared for them so they would wash their feet. Usually a servant would do the foot washing. This would cool the guest off and make them feel better.

## John 13: 17

Topic: a) Knowing and doing.




■ Is this going to be a fun day? ■ Did he hear? Did he know what to do? ■ Did he do it?

Topic: b) How do we do?




■ Why did he pull the cord? (He wanted to)

■ The first step in doing what you know God wants you to do is to want to do it.

b) There's another boy who is going to jump out of the plane. His name is Harold. Harold is told the same things about jumping and pulling the cord to his parachute. Harold hears and he wants to do this. He jumps out of the plane, counts to ten and reaches for his cord but there's a real problem...he can't reach it. He tries and tries

### John 13: 18

### John 13: 19

■ The Bible tells us what is going to happen. Should we believe what it says? Why? (Because it's the word of God and everything the Bible said was going to happen...did. Everything it says is going to happen...will.)

## John 13: 21-22

Topic: a) It's sad when people let you down.

## John 13: 23

Topic: a) All are loved but one is closer.

a) There was a mom who had five kids. Mom loved every one of them the same but there was one of her kids, the youngest, a little girl, whose name was Mandy who was always with mom. The other kids liked to play



outside with their friends. Mandy like to stay with mom. The other kids liked to go to the movies. Mandy liked to stay with her mom and learn how to cook and do things. ### **John13: 23**

Topic: a) Could I...?


■ Does this make any sense?
