Topic: a) What does God want you to be?

John 15: 3




The next day a huge storm came. The wind was blowing so hard that the windows were shaking. The man stayed inside the house and was safe. He lived in that house for the rest of his life.




- This tomato abided in the vine.

There is a cave. It is dark and cold. There is a hole in the ceiling that is big enough to crawl out of.


If you crawl through the hole you can see the sky, the land, the flowers and animals.
