



🎬 Are they all good rules?

🎬 Actually there are only two rules...Love God and love others.

John 5: 17-21

Topic: a) Jesus is God (How do you know?)

He felt around the wall for the light switch, found it and turned it on. Instantly the room was filled with light. The boy was happy. It was much better to be in the light than in the darkness.


■ This boy went from one thing to another. From what thing to what thing?
