

Common Bible Study Methods:

1. **Inductive** - Teaches what is in the Scripture; Pulls out what is there.
CONTEXT IS KEY/CRITICAL.
2. **Deductive** - When you start with an idea and then look to find what the Bible says about it.

HOW TO STUDY THE BIBLE

- 1. Pray**
- 2. Observe what is written in the Scripture**
- 3. Interpret correctly what is written in the Scripture**
- 4. Apply prayerfully what is written in the Scripture to your life**

Golden Rule of Bible Interpretation

“When the plain sense of scripture makes common sense, seek no other sense. Therefore, take every word at its primary, ordinary, usual literal, meaning unless the facts of the immediate context studied in the light of related passages and fundamental truths indicate clearly otherwise.” - Dr. David Cooper

Guidelines for Interpreting the Bible:

- 1. Interpret your experience by the Scriptures. Do not interpret the Scriptures by your experience.**
- 2. Do not be dogmatic where the Scriptures are not!**
- 3. Determine when a passage is figurative rather than literal**
- 4. Do not rationalize the Scriptures**
- 5. Do not spiritualize the Scriptures**
