






"The Power of the Mob!" John 19:1-16

The Six Trials of Jesus


Religious Trials 1. Jesus before Annas (John 18:12-14, 19-24) 2. Jesus' Trial before Caiaphas & the Sanhedrin (Matthew 26:57-68; Mark 14:53-65; Luke 22:54) 3. Jesus' trial before the Sanhedrin (Matt. 27:1)

Civil Trials 4. Jesus before Pontius Pilate (1st time) (Matthew 27:2, 11-14; Mark 15:1-5; Luke 23:1-5; John 18:28-38) 5. Jesus before Herod Antipas (Luke 23:6-12) 6. **Continue of the set of the se** (2nd time) (Matt. 27:15-26; Mark 15:6-15; Luke 23:13-25; John 18:39-19:16)






Philippians 2:5-8 (NKJV) 5 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.
