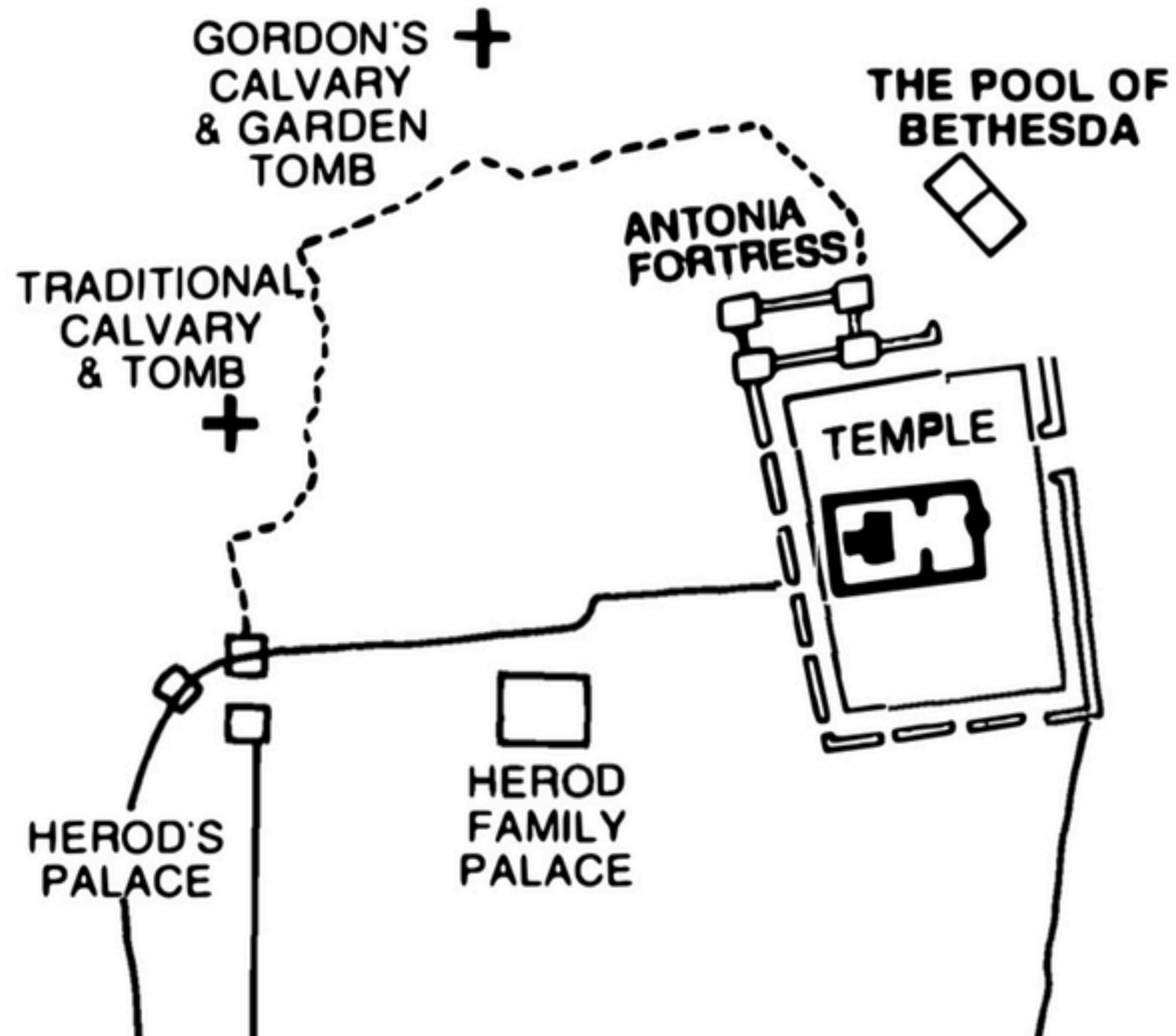




Golgotha, Jerusalem 1900

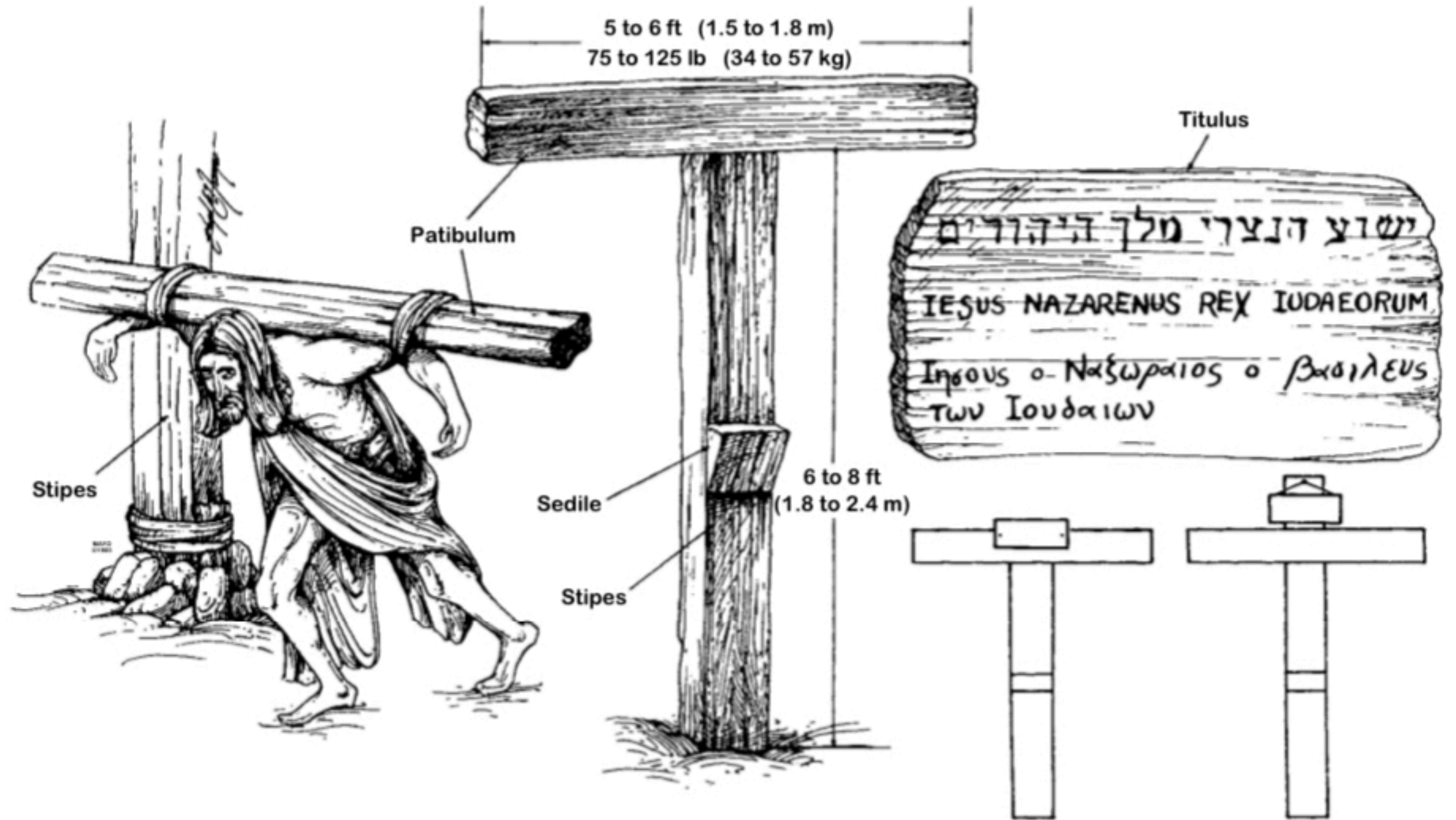


Location of Golgotha
