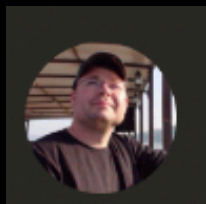

**\* Luke 5:1-11**

He said to him, <sup>l</sup>"Feed My lambs."
