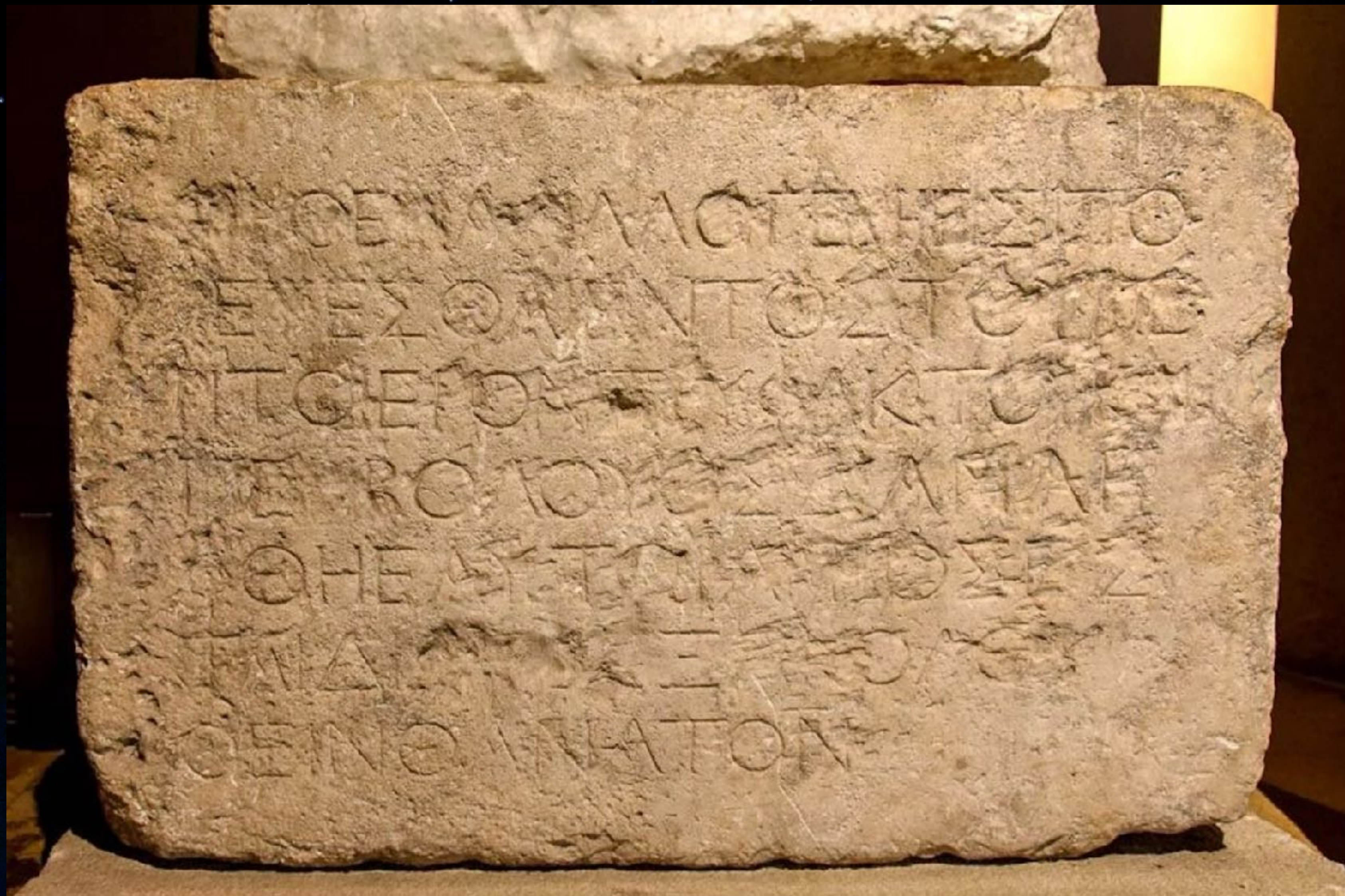

The word “parable” in the New Testament comes from two Greek words:

Para + Ballō = “to throw alongside

The idea is to compare two things side by side...

“Consumption of the fruit benefited the throat and lungs, counteracted poisons, and cleansed the kidneys. A plaster of figs was applied to boils and inflammations; the milky sap removed spots and warts, and was dropped into cavities to stop toothache. The fruit was used as a laxative, and as an aid in childbirth.”
