



Herod's Temple (20 B.C.-A.D. 70) was begun in the eighteenth year of King Herod the Great's reign (37-4 B.C.). According to Josephus, first-century Jewish historian, Herod's Temple was constructed after the old foundations were removed. The old edifice, Zerubbabel's Temple, was a modest restoration of the Tempie of Solomon destroyed by the Babylonian conquest. The central building was completed in just two years—without any interruption of the Temple services. The surrounding buildings and spacious courts, considerably enlarged, were not completed until A.D. 64. The Temple was destroyed by the Romans under the command of Titus during the second Jewish revolt in A.D. 70.
