John 6:15 (NKJV)

15 Therefore when Jesus perceived that they were about to come and take Him by force to make Him king, He departed again to the mountain by Himself alone.

After the Triumphal entry, Jesus would:

- 1. Cleanse the Temple the Second and last time**
- 2. He would contend and rebuke the Chief Priests and the Pharisees**
- 3. Deliver the Olivet discourse to His Disciples concerning end time events**
- 4. He would be betrayed by Judas**
- 5. Celebrate the Passover, The Last Supper, with His Disciples, institute Communion**
- 6. Be wrongfully arrested, arraigned and crucified (Which we will celebrate this coming Friday (GOOD FRIDAY))**
- 7. On the third day, rise again (RESURRECTION SUNDAY)**

- * The Year of Jubilee...Leviticus 25:8-17**
- * It is where we get our Sabbatical for
Universities professors.**

God's Prophetic Calendar

Jewish and Babylonian Calendars

*** Based on 30 day months, thus 360 day years.**

Examples: Rev. 11:2-3; 12:6; 13:5

x 7 (years)

x 360 (days)

- 3. Artaxerxes Longimanus - 458-457 B.C.***
- 4. Artaxerxes Longimanus - 445-444 B.C.***

The Four Decrees

First Decree

By: Cyrus of Persia, 536 B.C.

Reference: 2 Chronicles 36:22-23 & Ezra 1

Scope: Rebuilding of the Temple

The Four Decrees

Second Decree

By: Darius, 519 B.C

Reference: Ezra 5-6:1-12

**Scope: Rebuilding of the Temple,
a reiteration of Cyrus' Decree
previously but now
with penalties attached.**

The Four Decrees

Third Decree

**By: Artaxerxes,
King of Persia, 458 B.C.**

Reference: Ezra 7

**Scope: Provision for the Priests,
sacrifices, articles
for the House of God.**

The Four Decrees

Fourth Decree

By: Artaxerxes Longimanus, 445 B.C.

Reference: Nehemiah 2

**Scope: to repair the walls
and rebuild the city**

Our Calendar

**When was this fourth decree
given to restore and rebuild
Jerusalem by Artaxerxes?**

March 14th, 445 B.C

Our Calendar

When did “Messiah The Prince” enter into Jerusalem?

April 6th, 32 A.D

The Math

445 B.C. - 32A.D = **476 years**

476 x 365 = **173,740 days**

March 14th thru April 6th = **24 days**

Leap Years = **116 days**

Total: 173, 880 days

Daniel 9:24-26

*26 “And after the sixty-two weeks
Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself;
And the people of the prince who is to come
Shall destroy the city and the sanctuary.
The end of it shall be with a flood,
And till the end of the war
desolations are determined.*

Daniel 9:27

27 Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; But in the middle of the week He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, Even until the consummation, which is determined, Is poured out on the desolate.”

Daniel's Seventy Weeks

March 5, 444 B.C.

Nisan 1 of Artaxerxes' 20th Year
Nehemiah 2:1-8

March 30, A.D. 33

Triumphal Entry on Nisan 10, A.D. 33
Luke 19:28-40

69 WEEKS

70th WEEK

$69 \times 7 \times 360 = 173,880$ days
March 5, 444 B.C. + 173,880 days = March 30, A.D. 33

1/2 Week

1/2 Week

Verification

444 B.C. to A.D. 33 = 476 years

476 years \times 365.24219879 days = 173,855 days
+ days between March 5 & March 30 = 25 days
173,880 days

*Messiah cut off after 69 weeks -- April 3, A.D. 33.

Rationale for 360-Day Years

1/2 week -- Dan. 9:27

Time, times, 1/2 time -- Dan. 7:25, 12:7;
Rev. 12:14

1,260 days -- Rev. 12:6, 11:3

42 months -- Rev. 11:2, 13:5

Thus: 42 months = 1,260 days = time,
times, 1/2 time = 1/2 week

Therefore: month = 30 days; year = 360 days

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
