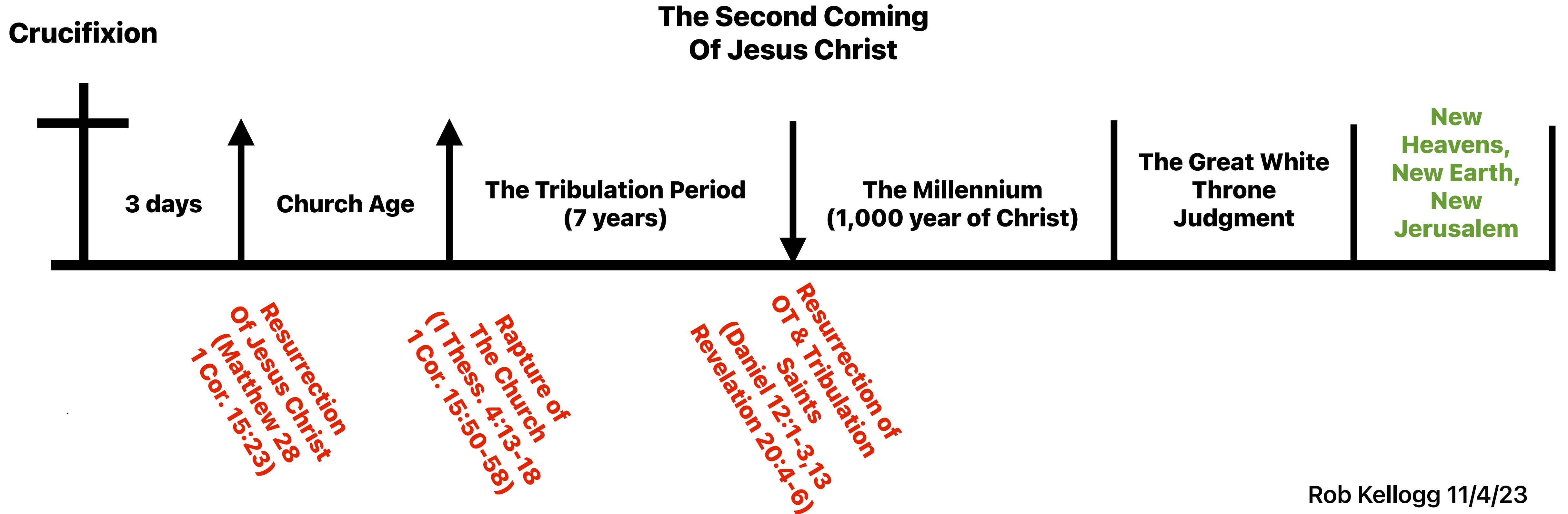
*** Deuteronomy 25:5-10**

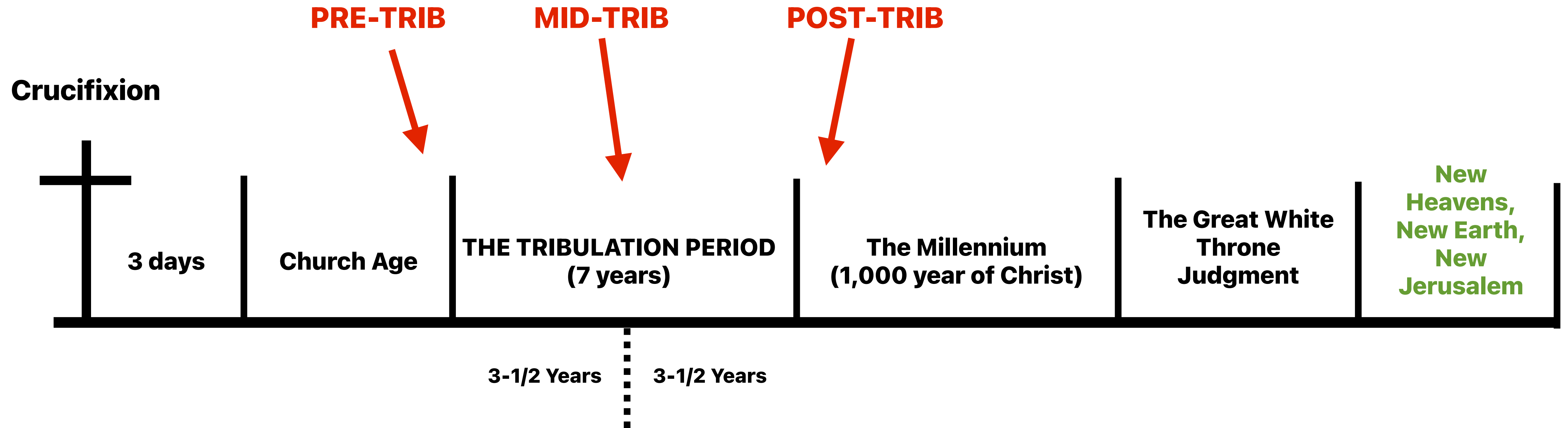
