




In his book "Understanding the Olivet Discourse," Thomas Ice said the following... "The sign of your coming and of the end of the age" in Greek reads, more literally, the sign of your coming and end of the age. By not repeating the definite article ("the") before "end of the age" Matthew's rendering of Jesus words is most likely linking the coming of Christ and the end of the age together as one event (Granville Sharp's rule).
