- 4. Jesus would share about the Rapture and the ministry of the Holy Spirit once He ascended**
- 5. His betrayer would be exposed (Judas)**

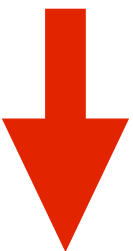

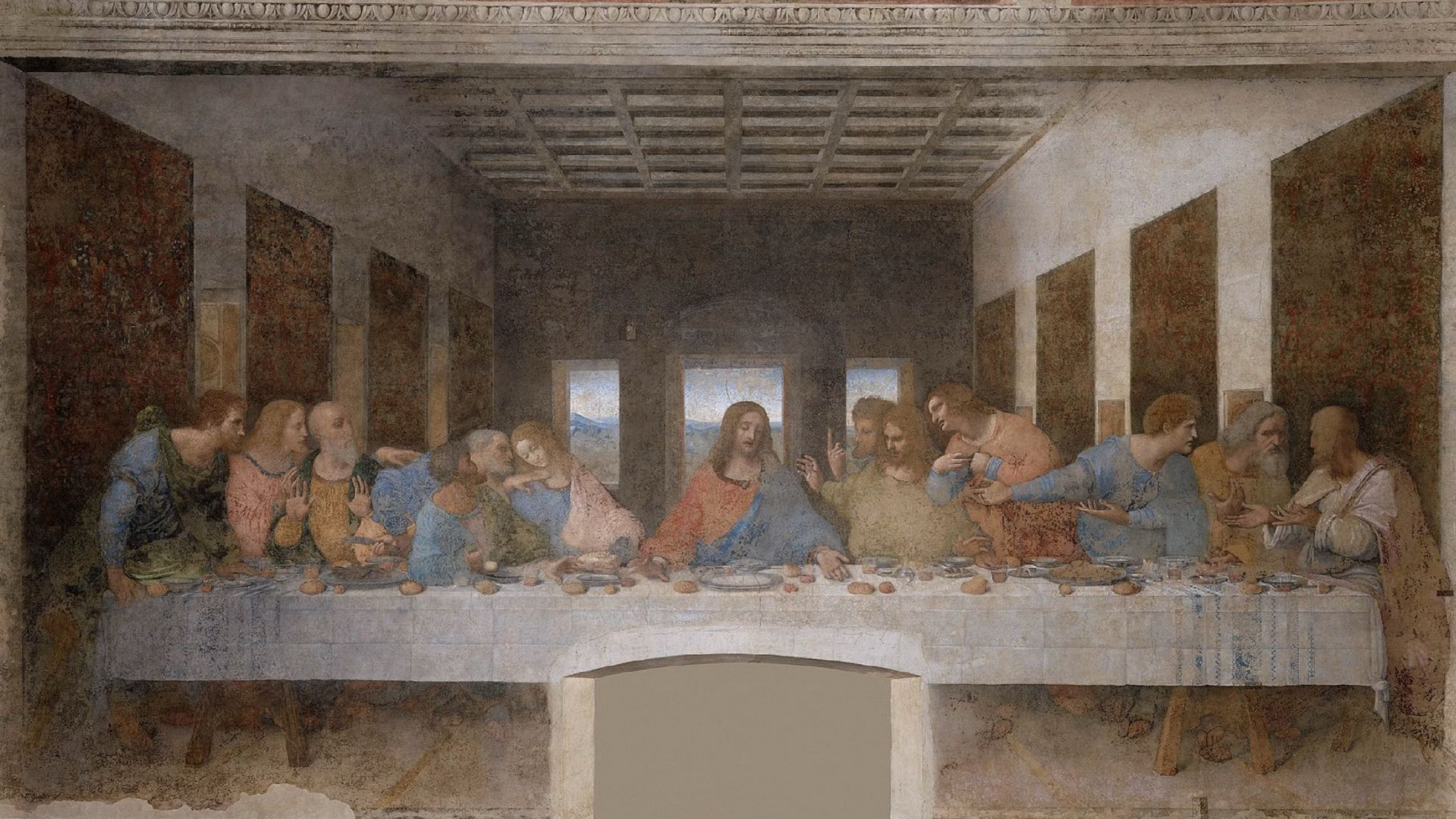

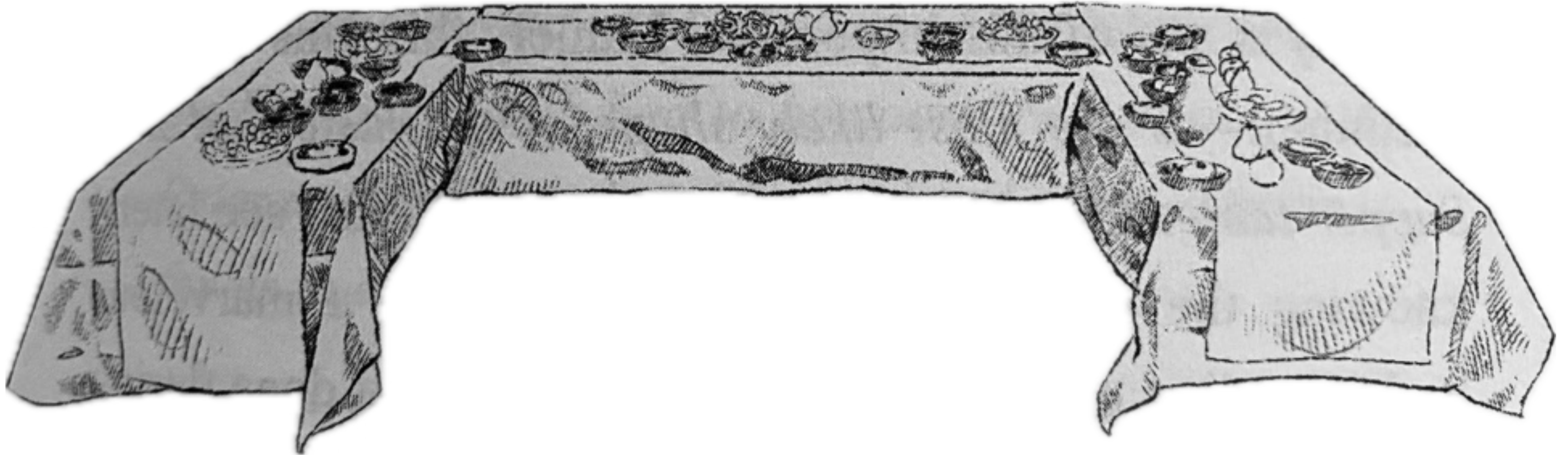
Upper Room Events in John 13

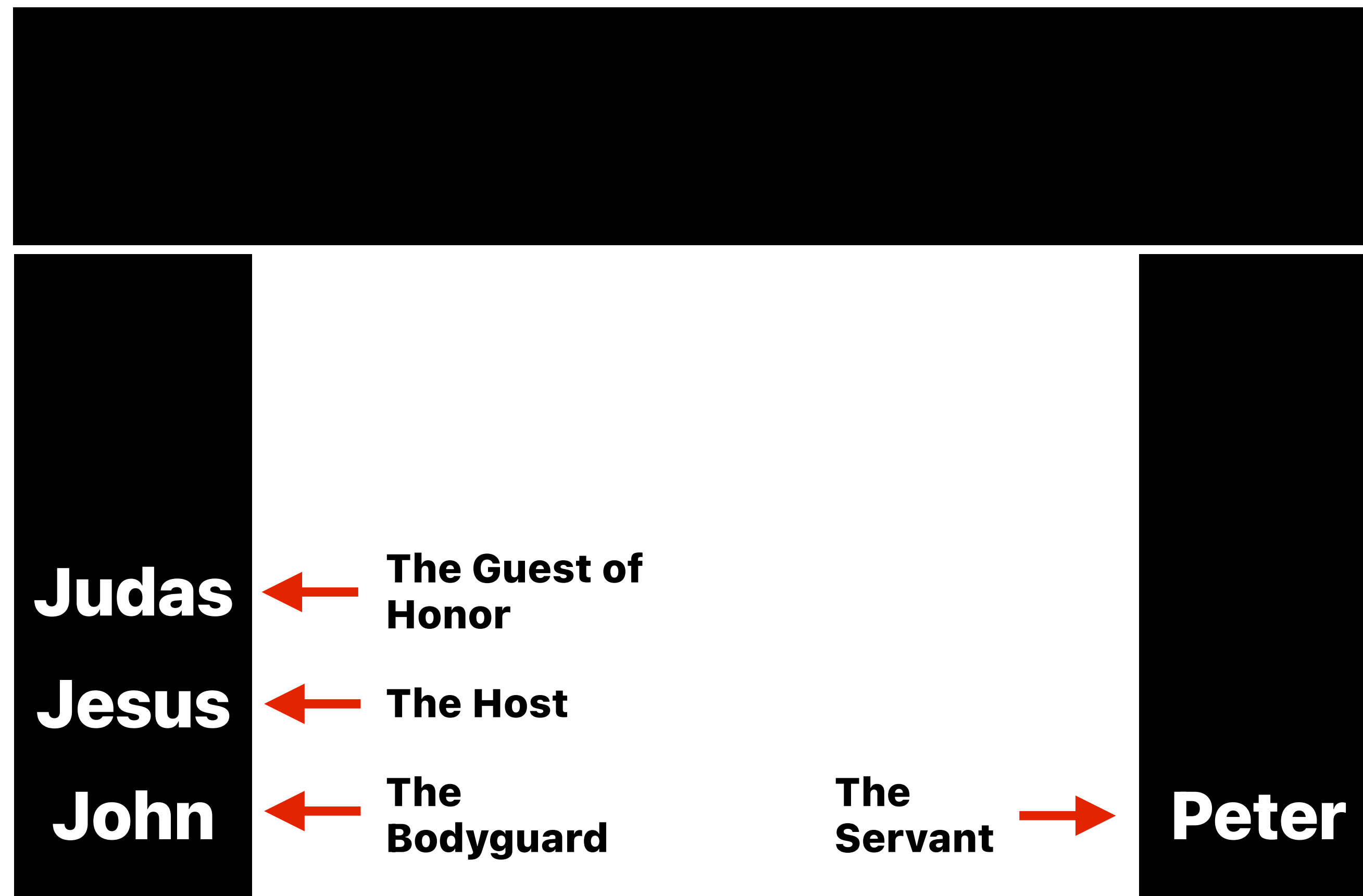
