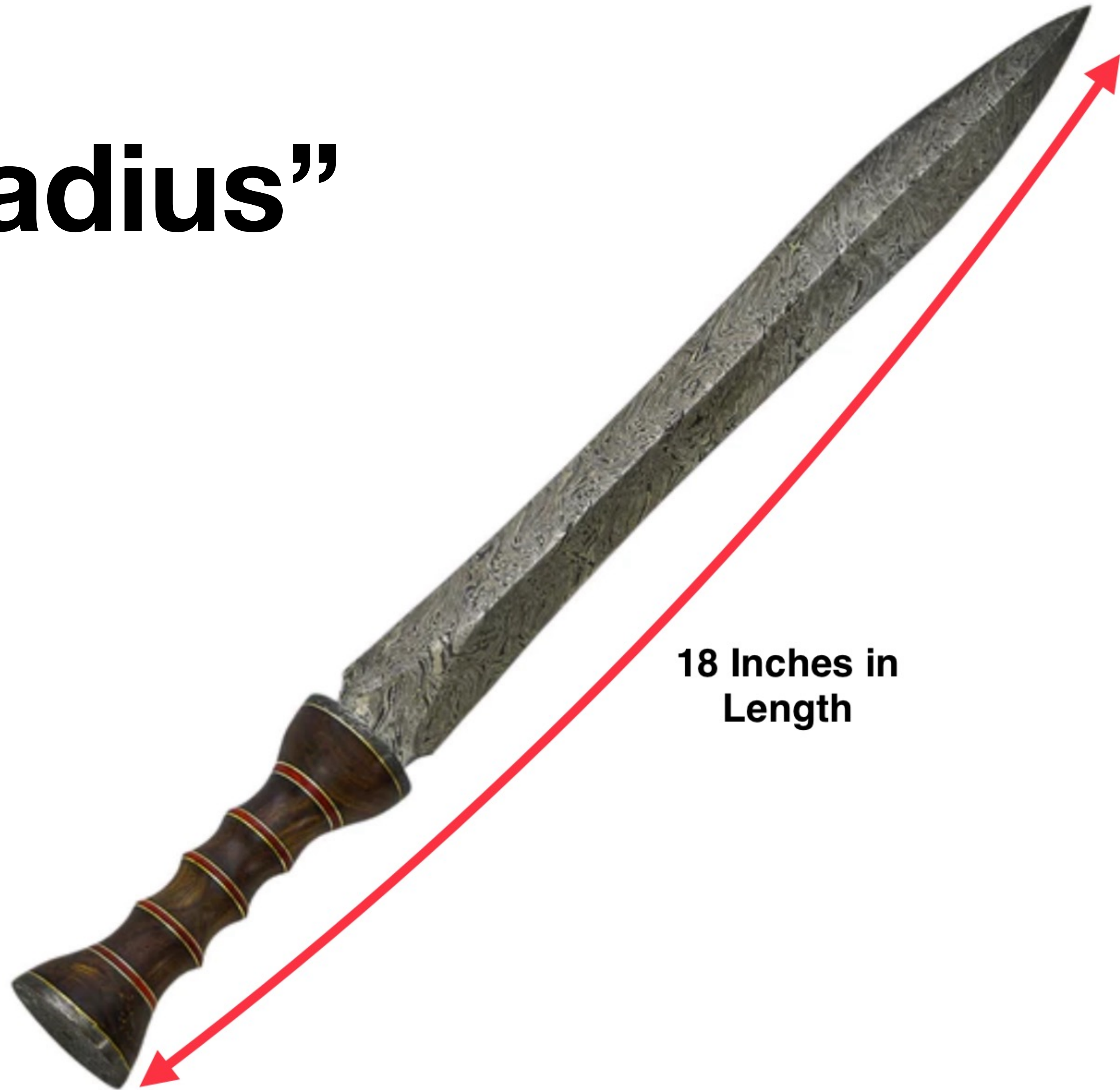

# The Six Trials of Jesus

(In Chronological Order)

## Religious Trials

1. Before **Annas** - John 18:12-14, 19-23
2. Before **Caiaphas/Sanhedrin** - Matt. 26:57-68; Mk. 14:53-65; Lk. 22:54
3. Before the **Sanhedrin** - Matthew 27:1-2; Mk. 15:1; Lk. 22:66-71

## Civil Trials

1. Before **Pontius Pilate** - Matt. 27:2, 11-14; Mk. 15:1-5; Lk. 23:1-5; John 18:28-38
2. Before **Herod Antipas** - Luke 23:6-12
3. Before **Pilate** - Matt. 27:15-26; Mk. 15:6-15; Lk. 23:13-25; John 18:39-19:16

***“One of the outstanding factors of the Jewish trial before Caiaphas is its illegal character....even the ordinary legal rules were disregarded in the following particulars:***

- The examination by Annas without witnesses.***
- The trial by night.***
- The sentence on the first day of trial.***
- The trial of a capital charge on the day before the Sabbath.***
- The suborning or bribing of witnesses.***
- The direct interrogation by the High Priest.”***
