

The Six Trials of Jesus

(In Chronological Order)

Religious Trials

- 1. Before **Annas** John 18:12-14, 19-23
- 2. Before Caiaphas/Sanhedrin Matt. 26:57-68; Mk. 14:53-65; Lk. 22:54
- 3. Before the Sanhedrin Matthew 27:1-2; Mk. 15:1; Lk. 22:66-71

Civil Trials

- Before Pontius Pilate Matt. 27:2, 11-14; Mk. 15:1-5; Lk. 23:1-5; John 18:28-38
- 2. Before Herod Antipas Luke 23:6-12
- 3. Before Pilate Matt. 27:15-26; Mk. 15:6-15; Lk. 23:13-25; John 18:39-19:16

"One of the outstanding factors of the Jewish trial before Caiaphas is its illegal character....even the ordinary legal rules were disregarded in the following particulars:

- O The examination by Annas without witnesses.
- o The trial by night.
- O The sentence on the first day of trial.
- The trial of a capital charge on the day before the Sabbath.
- o The suborning or bribing of witnesses.
- O The direct interrogation by the High Priest."

"This cowardly abuse of Jesus, was not limited to servants; the text indicates the Sanhedrin itself lowered its dignity to participate." - John Walvoord
