- 3. It would, hundreds of years later, disprove a fraud that people would venerate (God's Word also anticipates future heresies and fraud)**



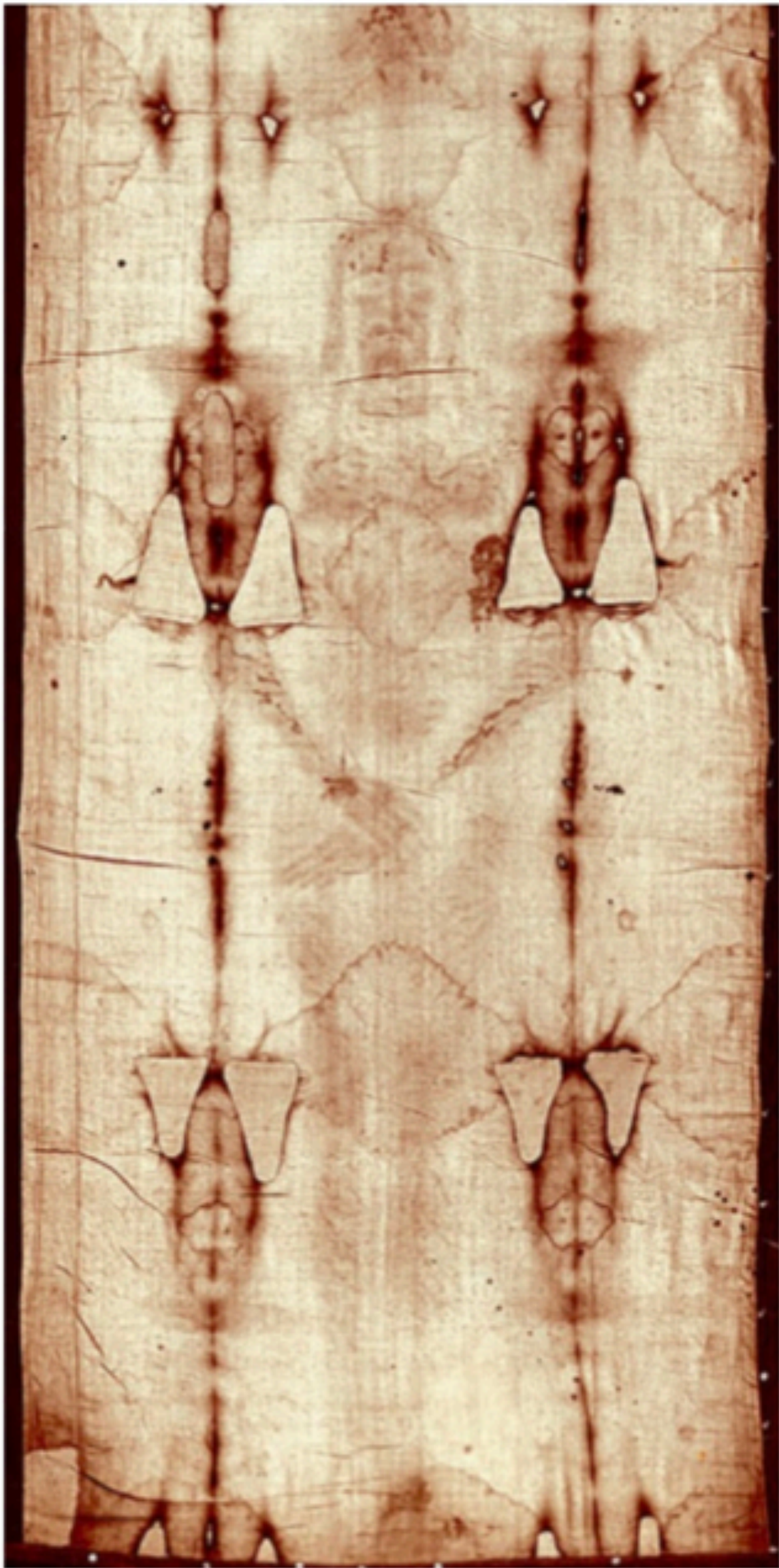
# **The Shroud of Turin**

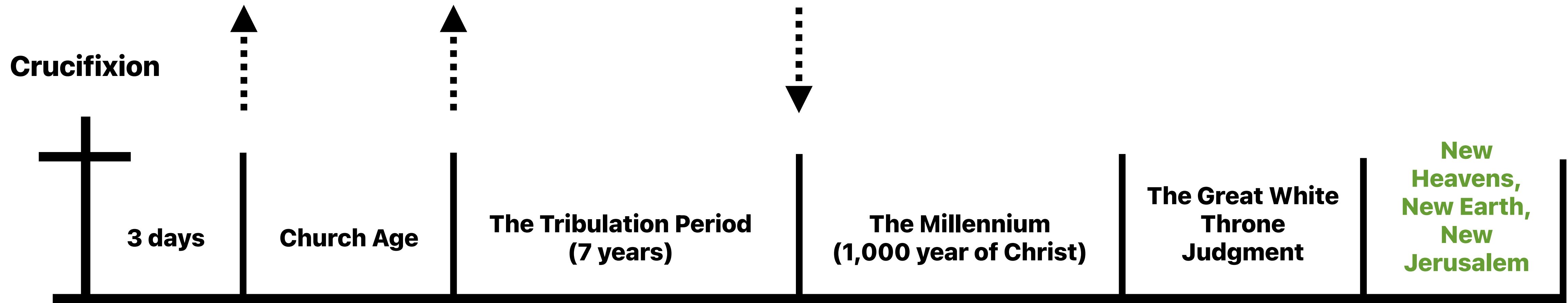
# The Resurrection

### The Second Coming Of Jesus Christ

#### KEY VERSE

**1 Corinthians 15:22-23 (NKJV)**  
22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. 23 But each one in his own order: **Christ the firstfruits**, afterward those who are **Christ's at His coming.**

# **BETWEEN VERSES 15 & 16, THERE WERE 4 OTHER EVENTS THAT OCCURRED...**

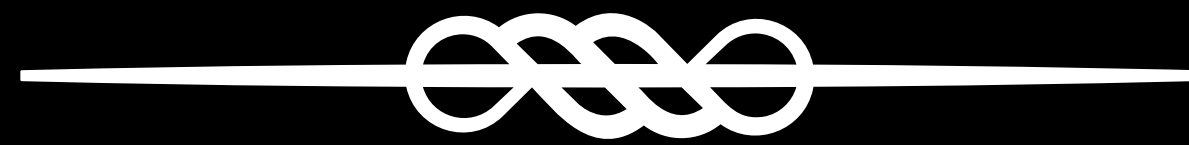
- 1. Jesus's talk with the two disciples on the road to Emmaus (Mk. 16:12-13; Lk. 24:13-35)**

- 3. Jesus appears to eleven disciples (John 20:26-31)**
- 4. Jesus appears to the disciples while fishing in the Galilee (John 21:1-25)**
