- 1. Philip (John 1:43)**
- 2. Simon Peter & Andrew (Brothers)
(Matthew 4:18-19)**
- 3. James & John (Zebedee's sons)
Matthew 4:21-22**
- 4. Matthew (Tax Collector) (Matthew 9:9)**

- 5. In (Mark 3:13-19,) the previously named disciples are listed with the addition of: Bartholomew (same as Nathaniel), Thomas, James the son of Alphaeus, Thaddaeus (same as Lebbaeus), Simon the Cananite, Judas Iscariot**
- 6. Matthew 10:1-42 (All of the above were put into a different order in Matthew 10, Peter listed first but Judas was always last!)**
