

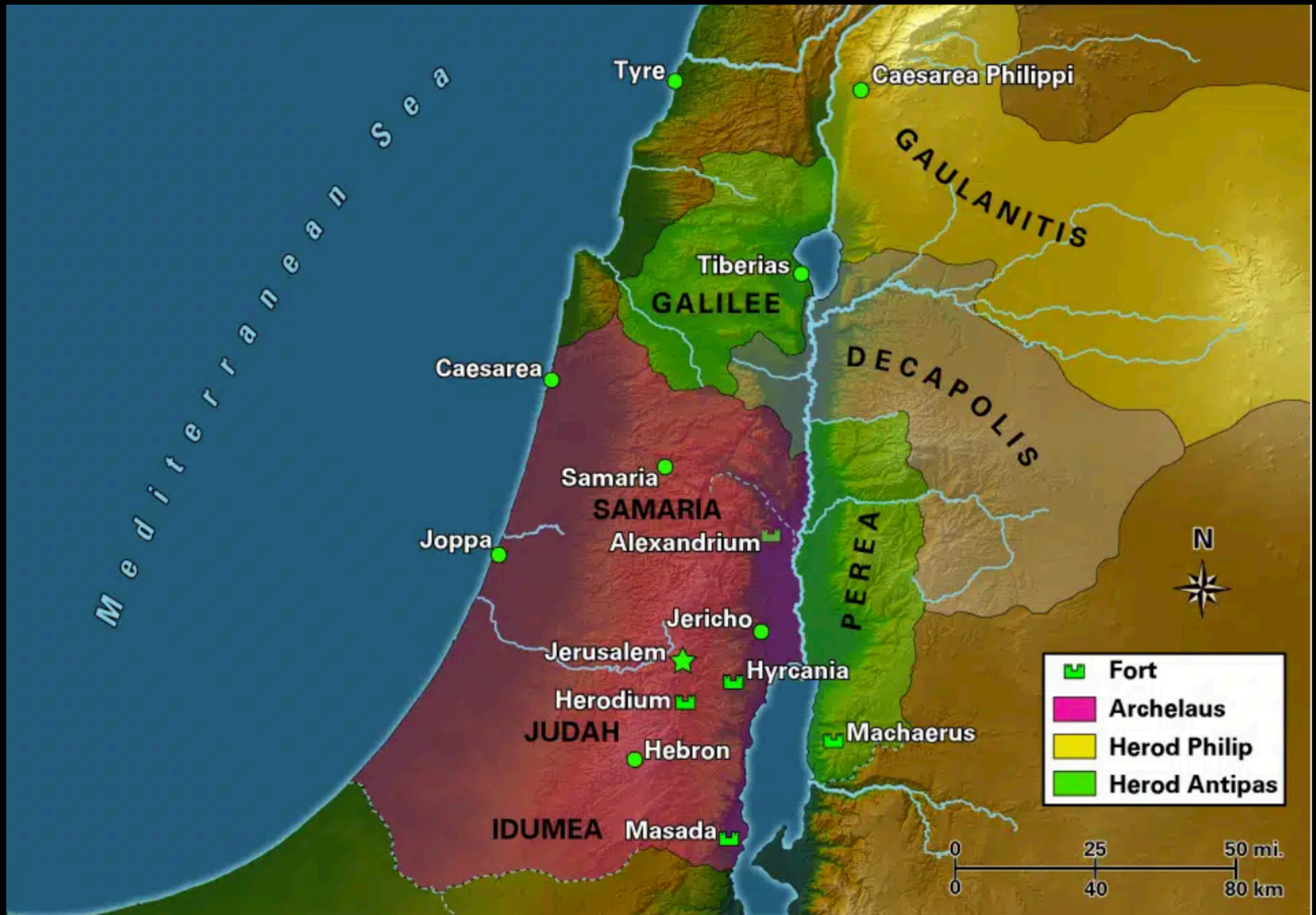

Matthew 11



Luke 3:19-20 (NKJV)

19 But Herod the tetrarch, (*Herod Antipas*) being rebuked by him (*John the Baptist*) concerning Herodias, his brother Philip's wife, and for all the evils which Herod had done, 20 also added this, above all, that he shut John up in prison.

Matthew 14:3-4 (NKJV)

3 For Herod had laid hold of John and bound him, and put him in prison for the sake of Herodias, his brother Philip's wife. 4

Because John had said to him, "It is not lawful for you to have her."
