Luke 3:1-2 (NKJV) 1 Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of **Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being** governor of Judea, Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, his brother Philip tetrarch of Iturea and the region of Trachonitis, and Lysanias tetrarch of Abilene, 2 while Annas and Caiaphas were high priests, the word of God came to John the son of Zacharias in the widerness.
