"False Prophets and Foundations"





A good shepherd:

- 1. Brings them to good pastures that have been inspected so that they can feed
- 2. Watches for enemies trying to attack the sheep
- 3. Defend the sheep from predators
- 4. Protect them from other dangers
- 5. Heal the wounded and sick sheep
- 6. Finds and saves lost or trapped sheep
- 7. Knows his sheep by name

* Deuteronomy 18:15-22

False Prophet is:

- 1. Someone who presumes to speak a word in God's name which God has not commanded them to speak
- 2. Someone who speaks in the name of other gods; not according to the revealed Word of God; or of the nature or character of God and His Son, Jesus Christ
- 3. A false prophet speaks things that are false; not true. Making predictions that don't come to pass

Characteristics of False Teachers (2 Pet. 2:1-19)

- 1. Bring in destructive heresies into the Church
- 2. Deny the Lord
- 3. Blaspheme the Lord
- 4. Are covetous

- 5. Exploit individuals with deceptive words
- 6. Walk in the lust of their flesh having eyes full of adultery
- 7. Despise authority
 - 8. Are presumptuous, self-willed
 - 9. Not afraid to speak evil or falsely of heavenly powers or authorities
