

- * First mention of Matthew in the Bible (Matthew 9:9)
- * Last mention of Matthew (Acts 1:13)

WHO WAS MATTHEW?

- 1. Originally named Levi (Mark 2:14; Luke 5:27) who lived in Capernaum
- 2. Was a tax collector employed by Herod Antipas to collect toll or transport taxes
- 3. He was the son of a man named Alphaeus and thus, perhaps the brother or half brother of James, the son of Alphaeus as well. (Not James of Zebedee)
- 4. He was one of the 12 Disciples and the author of this Gospel account. Matthew was called as a Disciple later in Mark 3:13-19 & Luke 6:12-16

Mark 2:15 (NKJV)

15 Now it happened, as He was dining in Levi's house, that many tax collectors and sinners also sat together with Jesus and His disciples; for there were many, and they followed Him.

Luke 5:29 (NKJV)

29 Then Levi gave Him a great feast in his own house. And there were a great number of tax collectors and others who sat down with them.
